Canyoning	Injury	Severe	Medium	<ol> <li>All adventures follow the standard operating procedures as defined and provided by Scotland's Canyons.</li> <li>All guides are aware of the emergency action plan.</li> <li>All adventure leaders complete an activity report for each tour including a dynamic risk assessment of conditions, participants, equipment, access and egress.</li> <li>All guides hold a minimum of 16hour recognised first aid certification obtained within the last 3 years and carry a first aid kit.</li> <li>All guides have undergone recent and relevant training and are experienced in outdoor leadership with practised interpersonal skills.</li> <li>Adventure leaders have met the minimum criteria to be qualified as an Adventure Leader by Adventure Logic Ltd in the relevant location.</li> </ol>
Faulty Equipment	Equipment Failure	Severe	Low	<ol> <li>Adventure leaders perform a gear check in accordance with manufacturer's guidelines, prior to and following every canyoning tour and record in activity report.</li> <li>Adventure leaders care for equipment with appropriate storage and maintenance in accordance with manufacturer's guidelines.</li> <li>Adventure Logic Ltd performs an annual equipment review to ensure that all equipment meets accepted safety standards where applicable and is suitable for its intended use.</li> </ol>
Weather	Adverse weather conditions	Severe	High	<ol> <li>Appropriate clothing is worn at all times by all participants in canyoning.</li> <li>Current weather is regularly checked and recorded in activity log.</li> <li>Weather report is checked via multiple sources prior to every trip and recorded in the activity report.</li> <li>In case of conditions that may cause unacceptable risk the activity is adapted accordingly, postponed or cancelled.</li> </ol>
Participants	Antisocial Behavior	Mild	High	<ol> <li>Ensure that all participants in canyoning are not under the influence of alcohol or drugs.</li> <li>Make sure that all participants read and sign the acknowledgement of risk form prior to the trip.</li> <li>All guides have undergone recent and relevant training and are experienced in outdoor leadership with practised interpersonal skills.</li> <li>Adventure leaders have met the published minimum criteria to be qualified as an Adventure Leader in the relevant location</li> <li>Encourage active participation in safety through ongoing briefings to ensure that all participants are aware of and reminded of the risks and their responsibilities.</li> </ol>
Access/ Egress	Blocked access/egress	Severe	Low	<ol> <li>Ensure that functioning means of communication are carried at all times by guides and drivers.</li> <li>Changes to canyon and paths are recorded in activity report.</li> </ol>
